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WELCOME

I.School is an English based, non denominational pre-school. The main focus is for our pupils to have a grounded, experiential education. We believe learning through experience with fun methods, accelerates a child's understanding of the world we live in, and sees how I (the child) fits into it. We appreciate the individuality of every child and encourage self expression.

AFFORDING THE BEST TUITION

A R3000.00 refundable deposit is required on enrolment. Fees are payable in advance and are paid 12 months of the year. There is an early bird discount for parents who wish to pay annually. No cash will be accepted on the school premises in order to maintain the children's safety. All payments can be made by EFT or by cheque. Please remember to put your child's name as a reference. Siblings receive a 5 % discount on fees and the early bird discount still to pay in advance.

NOTICE

One month's written notice is required when leaving the school and no termination of the contract will be accepted from October until December. **NB: This is an open ended contract and unless written notice is given to us, your child will automatically be enrolled into the following year.**

Please note that any returned cheques / debit orders or bank fees thereof will be for the parents account. Fees are payable on the 1^{st} of every month but should they be paid after the 7^{th} an additional R150 will be charged.





Children may be dropped from 6.30 am and collected by 13.00 (half day) and 17.30 (full day)
PLEASE BARE IN MIND THAT OUR TEACHERS HAVE FAMILIES AT HOME WAITING FOR THEM, LATE COLLECTIONS OF
KIDDIES WILL RESULT IN A PENALTY FEE OF R50 AFTER 17:30, FROM 18:00 IT WILL BE R150, FROM 18:30 IT WILL BE R250
AND FROM 19:00 IT WILL BE R500.

The school year will be divided into four terms. The school will be closed for all public holidays, however during the school holidays we provide a holiday program free of charge for the children who need to be looked after in a safe, fun environment.

SCHOOL CLOTHING

A list of all requirements is in the prospectus for clarification on what you need to bring for your child. We advise all parents to dress their kiddies in comfortable clothing. Each child will be given a locker where their costumes, soccer uniforms, dance uniforms, jackets/jerseys and hats will be kept on a weekly basis and sent home when cleaning is required. (Please provide an extra set of clothes for "accidents".)

POTTY TRAINING

We do potty train any untrained child. A fun method is used to encourage each child and no ridicule or shouting is allowed as any method of discipline or learning.

Learning all things in life can be fun.

We encourage parents to talk to the teachers about the methods as a consistency of these methods will create rewarding results for us all. Toddlers will bring their preferred brand of bum cream, nappies and wet wipes.



SICK KIDDIEWINKS

We have a very strict policy when it comes to sharing germs. Please keep your sick ones at home so that there is no confusion about sharing.

Children who are sick will be removed from the class and assisted in sick bay. Their parents will be called to collect them. Should the parent not be able to collect a sick child an arrangement can be made for your child to be dropped off at home in the school bus (in the immediate areas).

Any medication will be given to the head teacher, and will be kept in the sick bay under lock and key. Written consent must be given in order for us to be able to administer the medication. An emergency medical form will be filled out by all parents in case of any emergency. All efforts will be made to contact the parents first, but the welfare of the child will be our priority in an emergency. Please give us as much as possible information on your child's medical status in the enrolment forms.

FOOD

Food or sweets from home are not allowed at school. The school will provide all meals and snacks. (Breakfast, lunch and three snacks)

A well balanced, vegetable loaded, menu has been used to create nutritious and tasty meals for the kiddies. Our cook Benjamin is well loved for all his gorgeous meals and delicious muffins/biscuits. Breakfast is served at 8:00 .Please have your child here early so they have time to eat before the school program starts.

Special dietary requirements for kiddies can be discussed. (i.e. vegetarians / halal / hindu.)
Birthday cakes/cupcakes are allowed to be brought to school, there is however a **NO NUT** rule for these occasions due to allergies.

WATER

Aquazania Water is an oxygenated and purified drinking water, which is used as any drinking water, tea or juice base for the children. It helps oxygenate all cells and assist in a healthier life. We encourage water to be drunk by all. Children must bring a water bottle to school for use throughout the school year.





EXTRA MURALS

We believe that exercise has a vital role in the development of your child.

We have therefore included ball skills, baby gym, percussion and water familiarity for Toddlers. Soccer, dance (Ballet and Hip Hop), athletics, swimming lessons, isi Zulu and music/percussion are available free of charge to all children over 3, as part of our extra mural curriculum.

Extra murals will be done during the day after class work so that all children can participate. We have Computer classes on offer, as an extra mural too, but this will be at an extra cost. Participation is encouraged but never forced. Parents are welcome to come and watch and cheer the little ones.

Uniforms/clothing must please be given to the teachers to keep in their lockers.

FUND RAISERS and SCHOOL EVENTS

As we are a new school we would like our parents to get involved, so we can all get to know each other. We would like to promote the importance of community and participation, as our children learn these skills from us. Participation for fundraisers is compulsory. A fitted contribution will be decided and charged to those who do not attend or participate.

Children love to participate in school functions and feel disappointed when they are excluded. Parents will be notified and reminded in our monthly newsletter of any special events.

TRANSPORTATION

With the increase of traffic in the area, we realise that parents have less time. We therefore offer collection, to and from school within the immediate area. (This is a limited service, on a first come first

serve basis.) The drivers have valid Public Drivers Permits and are employed by the school. They make use of our vehicles, which are managed by the school.

We look forward to becoming a part of your family and having you become part of ours.



The step by step guide to enrol your child into I. School

- 1. Fill out the enrolment form and bring it to us.
- 2. Make copies of his / her immunization form and birth certificate and send it to us as well as copy of parents' Identity Documents.
- 3. Pay the refundable deposit R3000.00
- 4. Get all the requirements on the List of "What I need for school 2021" If you have any questions with regard to why he/she might need something please ask us.
- 5. Prepare your child for their new school. Repeat positive affirmations to them on their new beginning and how exciting it will be. Buy them a new bag or outfit for their first day. Always reaffirm with your child that you will be back to pick them up later.
- 6. Bring them to school on their first day. Mark off your required items with their teacher.
- 7. Give them a big hug and a kiss when you are ready to go and leave.
- 8. Always be on time to collect them in their first week. Perhaps come a little earlier than normal to create confidence.




